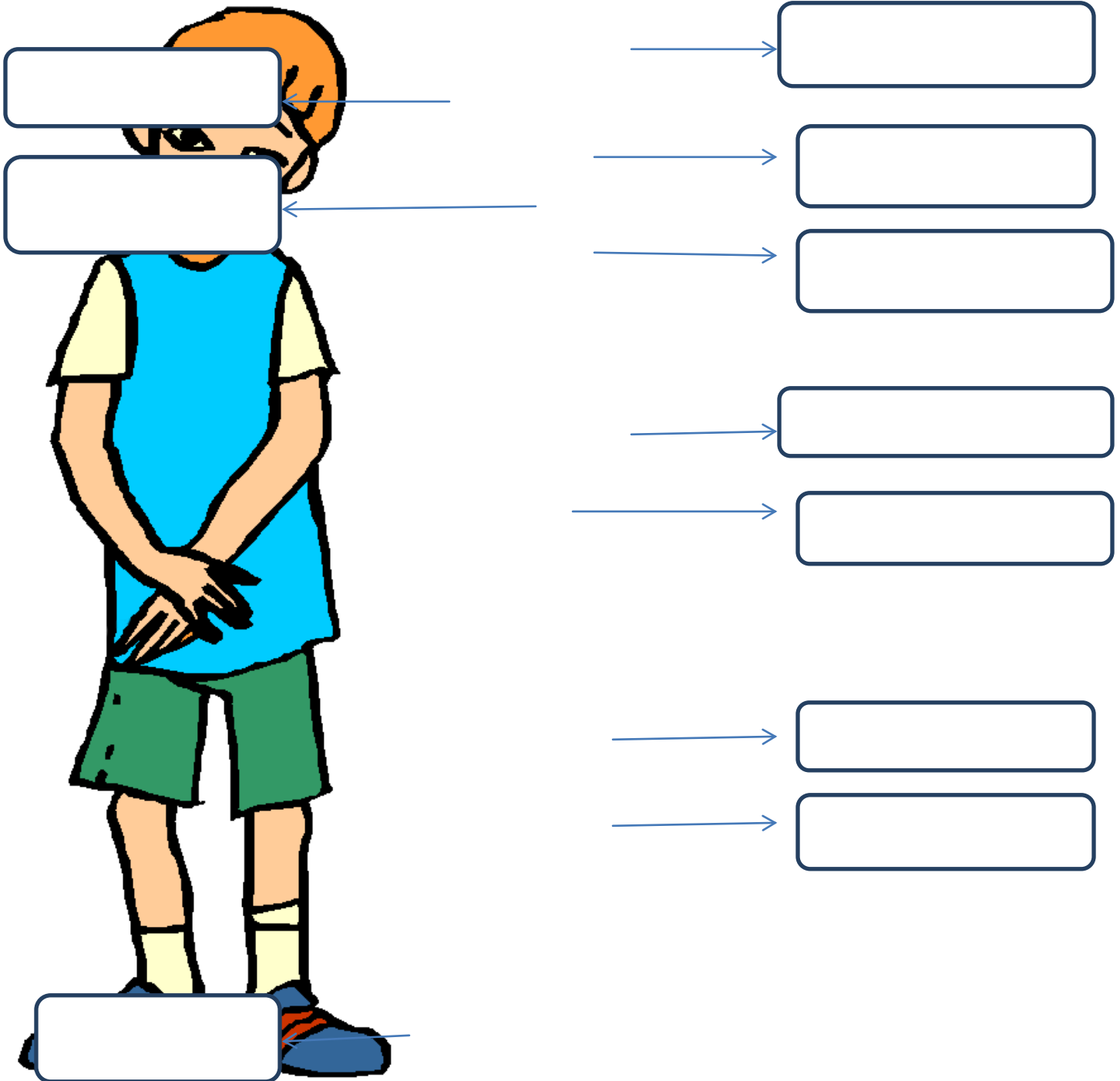
CREATING A DIAGRAM
