

Dear Parents,

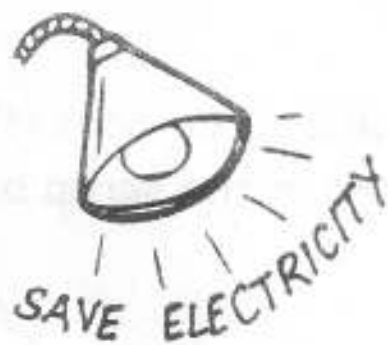

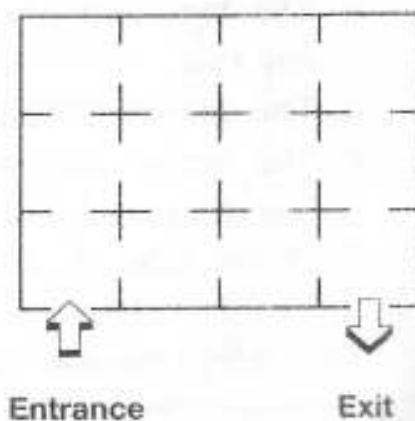
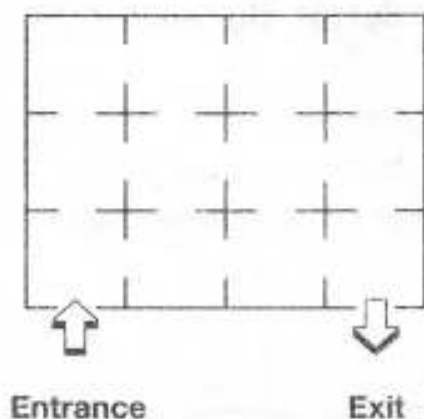
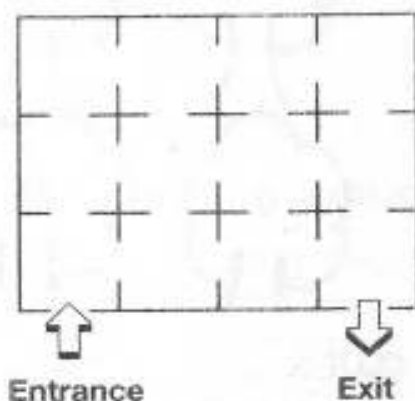
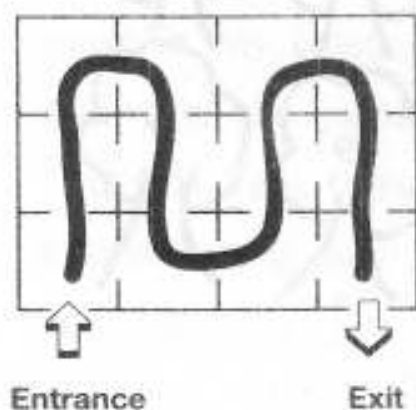
MATHS
