Late Kripasalyan Rai was born on 13th June, 1920 in Daramdin, West Sikkim. His father's name was late Harkabir Rai and his mother's name was late Lalmoti Rai. He was the eldest son. Till 11 years, he did not get the opportunity to go to school because of poverty. One day, one Mr. Phak Tshering Kazi saw Mr. Kripasalyan writing something on the ground with his friends who use to go to school every day. Understanding that Kripasalyan had great desire to read and write, Mr. Phak Tshering took him to Kalimpong where there was a school run by the YMBA (Young Men's Buddhist Association) and kept there in the boys' hostel as a cook where he also learned reading and writing. Later on this man became renowned in the field of literature and was awarded the Bhanu Purashkar by Sikkim Sahitya Parishad in the year 1988.

He is remembered as the pioneer for preaching and preservation of Rai Language.
Kripasalyan's actual name was Parsuram.

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
