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





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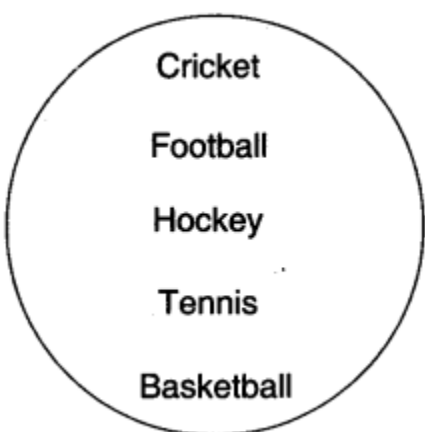
3. Do you know the name of any famous sports person in your area? If yes, write her or his name and the game with which she or he is associated.
