**Ans.** Both the houses have slanting roofs.

**Ans.** Such roof does not allow rainwater or snow to get collected on the roof.

**Ans.** People use lifts to go up in multi-storeyed buildings.

**Ans.** Houseboat floats and so keeps on moving on water. Other houses remain at one place.
