2.How did Chhotu use the pipe?

Ans. Chhotu used the pipe as a home.

3.Into which parts did Chhotu divide the pipe and its surrounding area?

Ans. Chhotu divided the pipe and its surrounding area into following parts:

•A part for sleeping

•A part for cooking

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- A part for drying clothes
- A part for storing water
- A part where guests can sit or guest room.

4. In which part of this house will Chhotu like to spend most of his time?

9. Is there any part of your house where a particular family member never goes or goes for a short time?

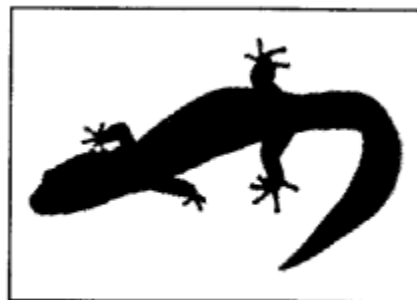
Ans. Yes, my father never goes to the kitchen or goes for a short time.
