Ans. The peon serves the food.

(f) Who washes the vessels?

Ans. To wash vessels, separate staff is there.

(g) Do the children miss home-made food sometimes?

Ans. Yes, children miss home-made food sometimes in the boarding school.

(h) Would you like to go to a boarding school? Why?

Ans. No, I do not like to go to a boarding school, because I will miss my parents there.
