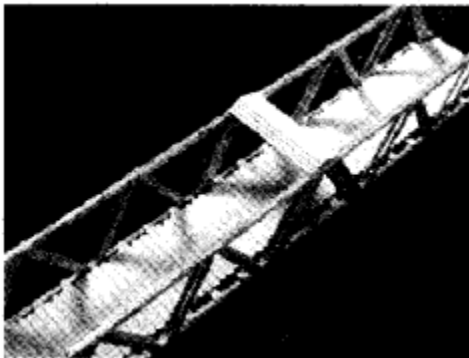
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11. Why not make your own bridge? For this, use material that you can find around you-ice cream sticks, plastic spoons, small sticks, rope, string etc.
