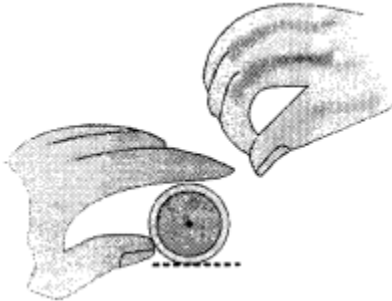

Hold the coin like this.



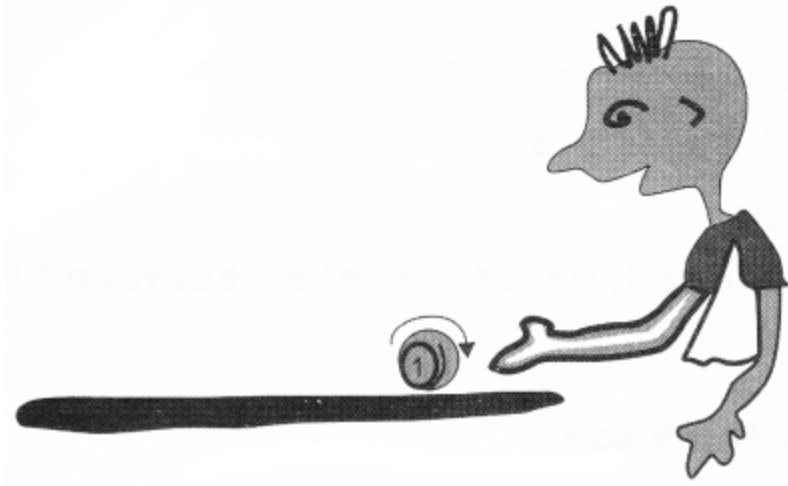
Question 6.
