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**Question 8.**

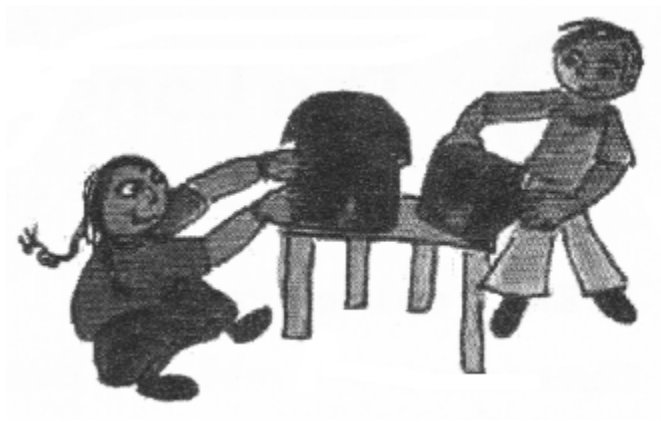
What would you use to find the length of those things?

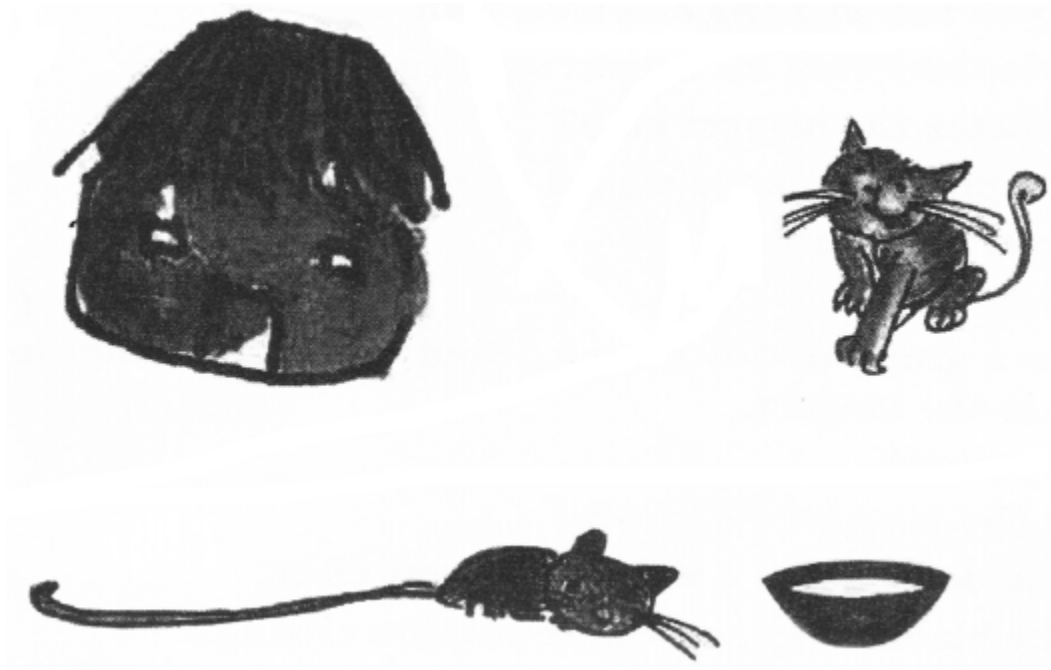
