Titu frog jumps over two numbers and reaches the third number. Where will Titu go next? Make a ring on the other numbers.

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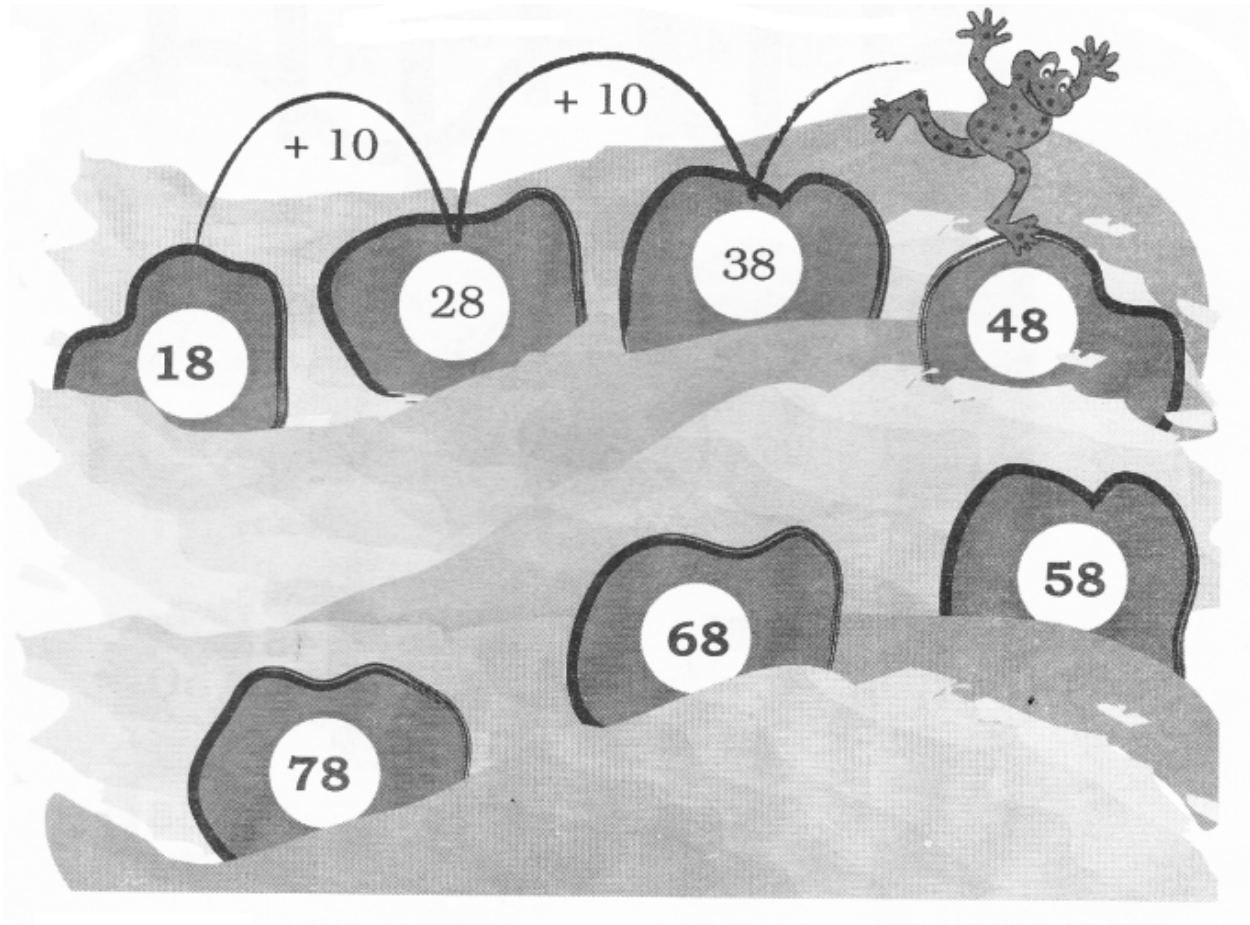

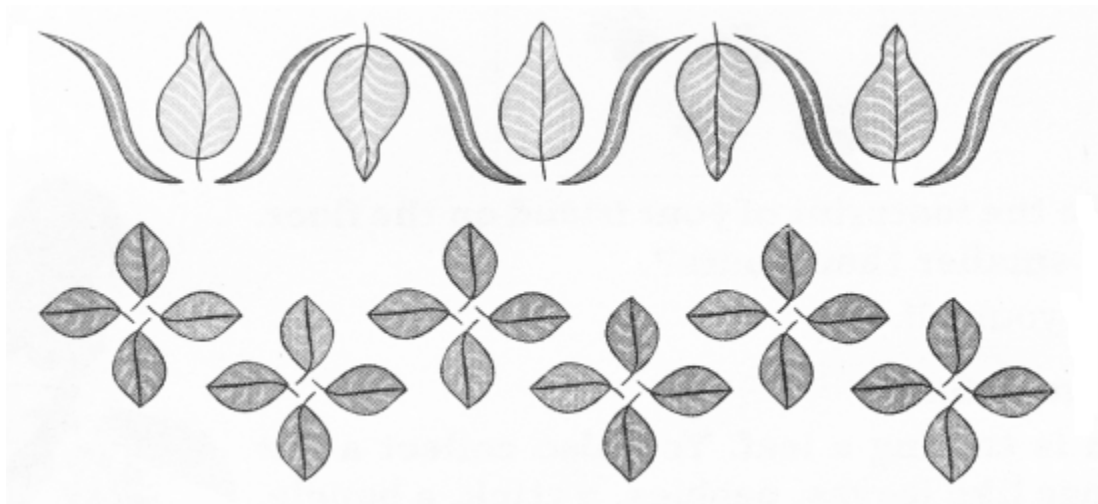
